Dear Parents & Guardians,

Due to the recent increase in local COVID-19 cases and to ensure we do everything we can to keep our members and team as safe as possible, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Yellowstone County will require all Club Members, Staff, Volunteers, and Guests to wear a face covering when inside our Clubhouses that serve students who attend Billings Public Schools. This requirement will take effect on Wednesday, August 25, 2021, and remain in place until:

- the average daily COVID-19 infection rate in Yellowstone County falls below 25 new cases per 100,000 people, or
- Billings Public Schools makes a change to their current masking requirement.

While I recognize there are numerous opinions regarding the wearing of a face covering, I am committed to doing all we can to keep kids safe and believe we must support the School District's position to avoid inconsistent messaging that confuses our members.
