We continue to expand our marketing and recruiting efforts and remain hopeful that the \$2.00 per hour part-time wage increase will help us secure the part-time professionals our members need.

At this point, if we can recruit, hire and train 6 part-time Program Coordinators (\$13.00/hour), we will be in a position to re-open the Castle Rock Clubhouse. Therefore, I am asking for your help promoting this opportunity to individuals you think would be a great fit for the Club and someone you would be excited to have working with your child. Dear Parents/Guardians,

While I do not have a date for when we can reopen the Castle Rock Clubhouse or when we can begin serving members at Broadwater and Eagle Cliffs, I did want to share that the Boys & Girls Clubs of Yellowstone County is doing *Whatever It Takes* to recruit more part-time professionals. Specifically, the Board of Directors has approved a wage increase of up to a \$2.00 per hour for our Clubhouse Staff. It is our hope that higher wages will improve our ability to recruit the part-time professionals who work with your children.

Despite our need to fill vacancies at all levels in each Clubhouse, we really need to hire numerous part-time Program Coordinators who start at \$13.00 per hour and who are the part-time professionals that plan and deliver the wide variety of daily programs and activities your children enjoy. The Program Coordinators are essential to our ability to safely serve your children and provide them with a world-class Club Experience. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Yellowstone County will continue our efforts to recruit new Program Coordinators, but I would ask each of you to help us spread the word and refer individuals you think might be a great fit at the Club. If you refer someone to the Club and we hire them, we will refund your 2021/2022 School Year Membership Fee.
